ABOUT THE CLINICS



HEAD COACH KEVIN TOMASIEWICZ

Coach Tomasiewic enters his sixth season as the head coach of the UW-Oshkosh baseball program. Tomasiewicz owns a 118-87-1 record at the helm of the Titans. In 2018, he led the Titans to their first NCAA Division III Baseball

Championship since 2008 and finished second in the WIAC race for the second-consecutive season. He has coached 10 players to All-WIAC selections and seven All-Midwest Region honors.



ASSISTANT COACH ZACH DEUTSCHER

Zach Deutscher enters his first season as the hitting coach of the Titans. Prior to his arrival in Oshkosh, Deutscher was an assistant coach at Central College in Iowa and North Central College in Naperville, III.

Deutscher was a three-time All-CCIW selection as a player at North Park University.



ASSISTANT COACH LUCAS GREGORY

Lucas Gregory enters his first season as the pitching coach for the Titans. Lucas just finished his playing career with the Titans baseball program last season. In 2018, he compiled a 5-4 record with one save and

one complete game. Gregory earned the programs first regional win in 11 years when he beat Bethel University, 4-3, in the opening game of the 2018 NCAA Division III Baseball Tournament.

YOUTH HITTING, PITCHING AND FIELDING CLINICS

These clinics will stress the fundamentals of hitting, fielding and pitching. Players will learn drills that are the foundation of our program. Instructors will stress the importance of sound fundamentals and the proper way to perform our drills. Video analysis will be used to breakdown the mechanics for both hitting and pitching. The goal of these clinics are to learn the game of baseball in a light and enjoyable atmosphere.

HITTING AND BASERUNNING CLINIC

This clinic is for players between the ages of 8-17. The clinic will focus on advanced swing mechanics and baserunning techniques. In this clinic, players learn the proper swing plane and how to sequence their body properly. Players will also learn the fundamentals of baserunning and various stealing techniques.

NEW YEAR'S EVE AND SUPER SUNDAY HITTING CLINICS

These clinics will be an introduction into our offensive approach at UW-Oshkosh. We will introduce variations on current hitting drills and extensive video analysis throughout the clinic. In addition to offensive drills, we will also incorporate hitter specific strength drills that we use throughout the year. The clinic will be focused on swing mechanics, knowledge of the swing and increasing bat speed.

PRESEASON PITCHING, HITTING AND FIELDING CLINICS

These clinics will be used for players to prepare and finetune their game for their upcoming season. Clinic I will provide a foundation of drills for the players, while Clinic II will have variations in drills taught in Clinic I in order to further prepare the players. Emphasis will be placed on repeatable mechanics of the swing and increasing bat speed. During the pitching clinics, players will learn proper throwing mechanics, and throw bullpens with current UWO coaches. All clinics will include instant video analysis.
