# HEAD COACH KEVIN TOMASIEWICZ

Coach Tomasiewicz enters his seventh season as the head coach of the UW-Oshkosh baseball program. Tomasiewicz owns a 136-108-1 record at the helm of the Titans. In 2018, he led the Titans to their first NCAA Division III Baseball

Championship since 2008 and finished second in the WIAC race for the second-consecutive season. He has coached 11 players to All-WIAC selections and seven All-Midwest Region honors.



# ASSISTANT COACH ZACH DEUTSCHER

Zach Deutscher enters his second season as the hitting coach of the Titans. Prior to his arrival in Oshkosh, Deutscher was an assistant coach at Central College in Iowa and North Central College in Naperville, III.

Deutscher was a three-time All-CCIW selection as a player at North Park University. Zach will work with the catchers and develop the offensive game plan of the team.



#### ASSISTANT COACH NAT RICHTER

Nat Richter enters his first season with the Titans. Nat comes to Oshkosh from Northwood University in Michigan. At Northwood, Nat helped guide the Timberwolves to consecutive

NCAA Division II regional appearances. Nat also has had coaching stints with St. Norbert College and the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League. Nat will work with the infielders and develop the offensive game plan of the team.

#### **DECEMBER CLINICS**

Our three clinics in December are designed to provide players with an opportunity to learn the drills that are the foundation of our program's offensive, defensive and pitching philosophies. Players can expect to be coached by the current UWO Coaching staff and members of the 2020 team. Each player will receive instant video analysis in each of the three clinics!

#### **SUPER SUNDAY HITTING & BASERUNNING**

This clinic will provide each player an opportunity to improve their swing and baserunning skills with the help of the UWO coaching staff. The drills of this clinic are designed to increase bat speed, improve swing mechanics and create an approach at the plate. The clinic will also cover baserunning techniques and tips.

#### **FEBRUARY (SPRING) CLINICS**

Each week players will receive video analysis of their mechanics. Each clinic is independent of each other.
